## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

## Sale of Property – Former Bed of Brexton Street

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in a certain parcel of land known as the former bed of Brexton Street and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in a certain parcel of land known as the former bed of Brexton Street, and more particularly described as follows:
- Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the west side 15 of Park Avenue, 66 feet wide, and the southwest side of the former bed of 16 Brexton Street, 20 feet wide, and running thence binding on the southwest side of 17 the former bed of said Brexton Street, Northwesterly 80.0 feet, more or less, to 18 intersect the southeast side of Tyson Street, 40 feet wide; thence binding on the 19 southeast side of said Tyson Street, Northeasterly 20.0 feet to intersect the 20 northeast side of the former bed of said Brexton Street; thence binding on the 21 northeast side of the former bed of said Brexton Street, Southeasterly 62.3 feet, 22 more or less, to intersect the west side of said Park Avenue, and thence binding 23 on the west side of said Park Avenue, Southerly 26.5 feet, more or less, to the 24 place of beginning. 25
  - Subject to a full width Perpetual Easement for all Municipal Utilities and Services, not to be abandoned, over the entire hereinabove described parcel of land.
