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A RESOLUTION ENTITLED

1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL concerning

2 **The Solid Waste Management Plan for Baltimore – Repeal and Replace**  
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4 FOR the purpose of repealing the Solid Waste Management Plan for 2013-2023 that was adopted  
5 by Resolution 14-019, effective October 30, 2014, as amended by Resolution 15-025,  
6 effective December 18, 2015; adopting the Solid Waste Management Plan for 2024-2033;  
7 providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the Solid Waste Management  
8 Plan for Baltimore City.

9 **Recitals**

10 State Environment Article § 9-503 and COMAR 26.03.03 require each county and Baltimore  
11 City to (i) adopt and maintain a comprehensive solid waste plan that covers at least the  
12 succeeding 10-year period, and (ii) periodically review and, as needed, amend or revise its plan.

13 The City’s most recent plan, the Solid Waste Management Plan for 2013-2023, was adopted  
14 by Resolution 14-019, effective October 30, 2014, as amended by Resolution 15-025, effective  
15 December 18, 2015.

16 The Department of Public Works has prepared a new solid waste management plan for the  
17 City.

18 **SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
19 Baltimore City Solid Waste Management Plan for 2013-2023 is repealed.

20 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Baltimore City Solid Waste  
21 Management Plan for 2024-2033 is approved and adopted.

22 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a copy of the Baltimore City Solid Waste  
23 Management Plan for 2024-2033 shall be maintained on file with the Department of Public  
24 Works and the Department of Legislative Reference.

25 **SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That this Resolution takes effect on the date it  
26 is enacted.
