RE: City Council Bill 08-0052 – Littering- Penalties

Dear President and Members

You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 08-0052. City Council Bill 52 will increase the criminal and prepayable citation penalties for certain littering offenses.

Article II, Section 48 of the Charter gives the Mayor and City Council the authority to provide for civil and criminal fines and penalties for the violation of any ordinance, rule or regulation provided that not fine or penalty shall exceed \$1,000. The fines provided for in City Council Bill 08-0052 do not exceed \$1,000. The Bill is therefore consistent with the authority of t he City Council.

The Law Department, therefore, approves the City Council Bill 08-0052 for form and legal sufficiency.
