1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Termination of Administrative Parking Regulations – Peak Hour Parking Restrictions on**
3 **the 2800 Block of Echodale Avenue, the 4100 through 4900 Blocks of Hillen Road, and the**
4 **5000 through 5300 Blocks of Perring Parkway**

5 FOR the purpose of terminating peak hour parking restrictions on the 2800 block of Echodale
6 Avenue, the 4100 through 4900 blocks of Hillen Road, and the 5000 through 5300 blocks of
7 Perring Parkway.

13 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
14 peak hour parking restrictions imposed by the Department of Transportation under Article 31,
15 § 2-5 or § 2-6 are hereby terminated on the following block faces:

- 16 (1) Both sides of the 2800 block of Echodale Avenue;
- 17 (2) Both sides of the 4100 block of Hillen Road;
- 18 (3) Both sides of the 4200 block of Hillen Road;
- 19 (4) Both sides of the 4300 block of Hillen Road;
- 20 (5) Both sides of the 4400 block of Hillen Road;
- 21 (6) Both sides of the 4500 block of Hillen Road;
- 22 (7) Both sides of the 4600 block of Hillen Road;
- 23 (8) Both sides of the 4700 block of Hillen Road;
- 24 (9) Both sides of the 4800 block of Hillen Road;

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

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- 1 (10) Both sides of the 4900 block of Hillen Road;
- 2 (11) Both sides of the 5000 block of Perring Parkway;
- 3 (12) Both sides of the 5100 block of Perring Parkway;
- 4 (13) Both sides of the 5200 block of Perring Parkway; and
- 5 (14) Both sides of the 5300 block of Perring Parkway.

6 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
7 after the date it is enacted.
