**INTRODUCTION** - City Property - Renaming Cottage Avenue Park to Candy Stripe Park

**PURPOSE/PLANS** - For the purpose of changing the name of Cottage Avenue Park, located at North East Side 30 Foot Alley 2nd South West of Cottage Avenue Rear 3700-36 Cottage Avenue (Block 3335, Lot 067), to Candy Stripe Park.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 23-0423 seeks to formally rename the existing Cottage Avenue Park to Candy Stripe Park. The existing park, located within the community of Park Circle has long been referred to as Candy Stripe Park by local residents. The park’s renaming embraces and formalizes the community’s longstanding tradition.
