10	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in	
11	accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either	
12	public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property	
13	known as 3904 White Avenue (Block 5691, Lot 005), and more particularly described as	
14	follows:	
15	The subject parcel, 3904 White Avenue (Block 5691, Lot 005), is an unimproved	
16	lot,	
17	containing 15,333.12 square feet, more or less, this property being no longer needed for public	
18	use.	
19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance	
20	unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.	
21	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it	
22	is enacted.
