INTRODUCTION – City Streets - Naming an Unnamed Alley, Located in the Rear of 216 East Biddle Street, Mura Alley

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of naming an unnamed alley, located in the rear of 216 East Biddle Street, between Hunter Street and Guilford Avenue, Mura Alley.

COMMENTS – The unnamed alley aligns with the nearby 700 block of East Mura Street, which exists five blocks immediately east. For this reason, DOT is recommending a minor amendment, changing the proposed name from Mura Alley to the 200 block of East Mura Street. The use of Mura Street would not be duplicative – it would merely expand the use of the name.

AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION – The Department of Transportation foresees no significant fiscal or operational impact resulting from the advancement of Council Bill 20-0607. The Department of Transportation position for Council Bill 20-0607 is **support with amendment**.
