INTRODUCTION – Corrective Bill 2021 - Definitions; Rules of Interpretation; Time Computations

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of repealing the many definitions and rules of statutory interpretation and time computation that have been superseded by the enactment of Code-wide, standardized definitions and rules; clarifying certain purposeful variations; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 21-0124 looks to repeal a variety of existing definitions within the City Code and replace with a standardized set of definitions. The new standardized definitions stand to reduce conflicts and redundancy within the City Code.
