At its regular meeting of October 15, 2015, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation considered the designation of Greater Faith Baptist Church as a Baltimore City Landmark.

In its consideration of this action, the Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation reviewed the attached staff report and made the following motion to recommend approval for designating Greater Faith Baptist Church, 3000-3004 Huntingdon Avenue, as a Baltimore City Landmark:

Approve staff recommendation to approve landmark designation because the proposed designation meets *Guideline 5.1 Criteria for Designating Districts and Landmarks* as the structure meets Criteria 1 for its association with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of Baltimore history; and Criteria 3 for its embodiment of the distinctive characteristics of a type, period, or method of construction, or that represent the work of a master, or that possess high artistic values, or that represent a significant and distinguishable entity whose components may lack individual distinction.
