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**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**Urban Renewal – Druid Heights –  
Amendment 6**

3 FOR the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Druid Heights to reauthorize the  
4 acquisition of properties within the Project Area, to remove certain properties from the list in  
5 Appendix A, and to correct and clarify certain language; waiving certain content and  
6 procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for  
7 the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing  
8 for a special effective date.

**Recitals**

14  
15 The Urban Renewal Plan for Druid Heights was originally approved by the Mayor and City  
16 Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 77-376 and last amended by Ordinance 10-298.

17 An amendment to the Urban Renewal Plan for Druid Heights is necessary to reauthorize the  
18 Plan's powers of acquisition and condemnation so that these actions may legally continue, in  
19 compliance with § 12-105.1 of the Real Property Article of the Annotated Code of Maryland, to  
20 remove certain properties from the list in Appendix A, and to correct and clarify certain  
21 language.

22 Under Article 13, § 2-6 of the Baltimore City Code, no ~~substantial~~ change may be made in  
23 any approved renewal plan unless the change is approved in the same manner as that required for  
24 the approval of a renewal plan.

25 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
26 following changes in the Urban Renewal Plan for Druid Heights are approved:

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1 (1) In the Plan, amend the first paragraph of C.1. a. to read as follows:

2 C. Techniques Used to Achieve Plan Objectives

3 1. Acquisition

4 a. Purpose for Acquiring Properties Within the Project Area

5 Properties designated for acquisition on the Property Acquisition Map,  
6 Exhibit 2, will be acquired BY PURCHASE OR BY CONDEMNATION either for  
7 clearance and redevelopment, for rehabilitation, or for public facilities.  
8

9 (2) In the Plan, add new C.1.d. to read as follows:

10 C. Techniques Used to Achieve Plan Objectives

11 1. Acquisition

12 . . . .

13 D. THE AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE THE PROPERTIES WITHIN THE PROJECT AREA  
14 IS EXPRESSLY CONFIRMED AND REAUTHORIZED THROUGH AND INCLUDING  
15 DECEMBER 31, 2014.

16 (3) In the Plan, amend the first paragraph of Appendix A to read as follows:

17 Appendix A

18 Properties for Acquisition and Disposition for Rehabilitation

19 The following properties are being acquired and disposed of for rehabilitation. IN  
20 ADDITION TO THOSE GROUPS OF PROPERTIES TO BE ACQUIRED AND DISPOSED OF FOR  
21 REDEVELOPMENT, THE FOLLOWING PROPERTIES ARE ALSO BEING ACQUIRED AND  
22 DISPOSED OF FOR REHABILITATION OR REDEVELOPMENT. Certain properties listed  
23 below may be used, in whole or in part, as rear or side yard space for adjacent  
24 property. THE ACQUISITION PROPERTIES ADJACENT TO OR ABUTTING STREETS AND  
25 ALLEYS BEING CLOSED WILL ALSO INCLUDE ALL RIGHTS, TITLE AND INTEREST, OR ANY  
26 PRIVATE RIGHTS OF USE IN AND TO THE ADJACENT STREETS, RIGHTS-OF-WAY, OR  
27 ALLEYS AS SHOWN LYING WITHIN THE PERIMETER OF THE LAND DISPOSITION MAP.

28 (4) In the Plan, in Appendix A, delete the following from the list of properties:

- 29 578 Baker Street  
30 589 Baker Street  
31 593 Baker Street  
32 2307 Division Street  
33 1924 McCulloh Street

34 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That the Urban Renewal Plan for Druid  
35 Heights, as amended by this Ordinance and identified as “Urban Renewal Plan, Druid Heights,  
36 revised to include Amendment 6, dated January 31, 2011”, is approved. The Department of  
37 Planning shall file a copy of the amended Urban Renewal Plan with the Department of

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1 Legislative Reference as a permanent public record, available for public inspection and  
2 information.

3 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That if the amended Urban Renewal Plan  
4 approved by this Ordinance in any way fails to meet the statutory requirements for the content of  
5 a renewal plan or for the procedures for the preparation, adoption, and approval of a renewal  
6 plan, those requirements are waived and the amended Urban Renewal Plan approved by this  
7 Ordinance is exempted from them.

8 **SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That if any provision of this Ordinance or the  
9 application of this Ordinance to any person or circumstance is held invalid for any reason, the  
10 invalidity does not affect any other provision or any other application of this Ordinance, and for  
11 this purpose the provisions of this Ordinance are declared severable.

12 **SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That if a provision of this Ordinance concerns  
13 the same subject as a provision of any zoning, building, electrical, plumbing, health, fire, or  
14 safety law or regulation, the applicable provisions shall be construed to give effect to each.  
15 However, if the provisions are found to be in irreconcilable conflict, the one that establishes the  
16 higher standard for the protection of the public health and safety prevails. If a provision of this  
17 Ordinance is found to be in conflict with an existing provision of any other law or regulation that  
18 establishes a lower standard for the protection of the public health and safety, the provision of  
19 this Ordinance prevails and the other conflicting provision is repealed to the extent of the  
20 conflict.

21 **SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it  
22 is enacted.
