14	accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-409(1) and			
15	14-102, subject to the following conditions:			
16	1. A maximum of 50 beds may be used for emergency overnight housing for homeless			
17	persons.			
18	2. The home for homeless persons must comply with all applicable federal, state, and			
19	local licensing and certification requirements.
