| SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That |
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| \$12,300,000 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 315 (Emergency |
| Services) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2023, to |
| provide funding for balancing the Health Department budget for Fiscal Year 2023 due to costs |
| associated with provider contracts and support services related to COVID. The source of |
| revenue for this appropriation is generated from investment earnings in excess of the amount |
| from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required |
| to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2023. |
