Dear President and City Council Members:

You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 10-0588. Bill 10-0588 is a resolution approving the issuance by the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners of the Baltimore City Public School System revenue bonds. Maryland Ann. Code, Education Art. Sec. 4-306.2(d) states that “[b]efore the board may issue a bond under this section, the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall pass a resolution approving the board’s issuance of the bond and shall forward that resolution to the board.”

City Council Bill 10-0588 is the resolution required by State law under Sec. 4-306.2(d) of the Education Article to approve the issuance of the School Revenue Bonds. The Law Department therefore approves City Council Bill 10-0588 for form and legal sufficiency.
