## Recommended Position

The Office of the Labor Commissioner is in support of a charter amendment authorizing multiyear collective bargaining with certified employee organizations, provided such charter amendment contains those conditions imposed on multi-year collective bargaining agreements for Baltimore Fire Fighters, IAFF Local 734 (Local 734) and the Baltimore Fire Officers, IAFF Local 964 (Local 964).

## Comments and Analysis

The Office of the Labor Commissioner is in support of multi-year bargaining agreements for other certified employee organizations as long as they contain the same parameters listed for Local 964 and Local 734 in the Baltimore City Charter Art. V1, §12.

The Baltimore City Charter Art. VI, § 12 authorizes multi-year collective bargaining agreements for Baltimore Fire Fighters, IAFF Local 734 and the Baltimore Fire Officers, IAFF Local 964. The Board of Estimates may approve such agreements for terms of not less than one (1) fiscal year and not more than three (3) consecutive fiscal years, so long as any collective bargaining agreement does not extend beyond the fiscal year in which the current Mayor's term of office ends.
