I am herein reporting on City Council Bill No. 09-0410.

Urban Renewal Plan - Carroll Camden – Amendment

For the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Carroll Camden to revise an exhibit to reflect the disposition changes in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances and providing for a special effective date.

The Department of Transportation has reviewed City Council Bill 09-0410 which was introduced for the purpose of amending the Carroll Camden Urban Renewal Plan to grant the City the authority to sell 701 W. Ostend Street and the bed of Warner Street between Bayard and Worcester Street to the Baltimore City Entertainment Group. These properties will be combined into the overall disposition area that will be part of the future site of a video lottery facility.

The Department of Transportation has no objections to the passage of the bill.
