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**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

1    **Sale of Property – 1220 East Oliver Street**

2            FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public  
3            or private sale, all its interest in certain property known as 1220 East Oliver Street (Block  
4            1123, Lot 017) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective  
5            date.

6            BY authority of  
7            Article II - General Powers  
8            Section 15(c)  
9            Baltimore City Charter

11           **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That, in  
12           accordance with Article II, § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and  
13           Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor  
14           and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 1220 East Oliver Street (Block 1123, Lot  
15           017), and more particularly described as follows:

16                    The subject property, located in the Oliver neighborhood, is a vacant building that  
17                    was constructed in 1905, and used as a firehouse. The firehouse has been closed  
18                    since 2000, at which point it was surplussed to the Department of Housing and  
19                    Community Development. The building has a 2-story brick facade, with 3 entry  
20                    ports.

21            This property being no longer needed for public use.

22            **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That no deed may pass under this Ordinance  
23            unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.

24            **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is  
25            enacted.
