Summary of the Bill

Council Bill #20-0604 proposes to modify and conform the definition of minor child, in the Employees' Retirement System law, the Elected Officials; Retirement System law, and the Fire and Police Employees' Retirement System law, by establishing the definition of "minor child" to mean "the child of a member, former member, or retiree who has not attained age 22."

DHR's Recommendation

The Department of Human Resources has reviewed the above captioned Bill. The Department's position on the bill is favorable.
