INTRODUCTION – Zoning - Use Standards - Neighborhood Commercial Establishments

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of allowing the limited expansion of a non-residential use into a newly constructed addition to the principal building; and conforming and clarifying related provisions.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 19-0480 looks to permit non-residential use of newly constructed additions to properties that are classified as being neighborhood commercial establishments. This bill looks to amend the existing Zoning Code that was originally drafted by the Baltimore City Planning Department in the mid-2010s.

The Department of Transportation does not foresee any significant fiscal or operational impacts associated with the passage of Council Bill 19-0480.
