AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

**Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation –
M-R Office of Homeless Services – \$500,000**

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$500,000 to M-R Office of Homeless Services – Service 895 (Temporary Housing for the Homeless), to provide funding for case management services through the Y in Central Maryland and the University of Maryland, Baltimore/Uplift Alliance Inc.; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the State of Maryland's Department of Human Services in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.

On April 1, 2026, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

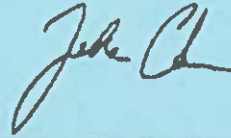
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SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$500,000 shall be made available to M-R Office of Homeless Services – Service 895 (Temporary
Housing for the Homeless) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal
Year 2026, to provide funding for case management services through the Y in Central Maryland
and the University of Maryland, Baltimore/Uplift Alliance Inc. The source of revenue for this
appropriation is the grant from State of Maryland’s Department of Human Services in excess of
the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax
levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
enacted.

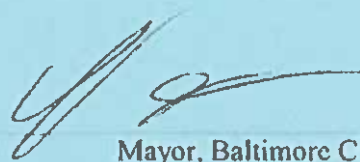
