**INTRODUCTION** – Urban Renewal - Washington Village - Amendment

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Washington Village to revise an exhibit to the Renewal Plan to reflect the addition of a new disposition lot and to clarify and correct certain references in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 20-0553 seeks to amend the existing Urban Renewal Plan for the community of Washington Village. Boundaries of the existing Washington Urban Renewal Plan are set to remain the same, though the amended legislation includes the addition of a new land disposition lot identified as Lot 25, located at 856 Washington Boulevard. The new land disposition lot is approximately 6,600 square feet and is identified as being in the C-1 Neighborhood Business Zoning District.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION** – The Department of Transportation foresees no direct fiscal or operational impact resulting from the advancement of Council Bill 20-0553. The Department of Transportation **supports** Council Bill 20-0553.
