The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #08-0043, which is for the purpose of removing the R-8 District from among those districts in which an exception may be sought from the general prohibition against converting 1- or 2-family dwellings to larger occupancies.

The Department of Planning recommends disapproval of this bill. We have serious concerns over the equity of the proposed exclusion of conversions in the R-8 District. If this change is made, conversions will still be allowable in the R-7 District, as well as in R-9 and R-10. Most importantly, not all R-8 Districts within the City are identical, and so the potential impact will not be the same. In some R-8 neighborhoods in east and west Baltimore, conversions are important for renovating what were single-family townhomes into two dwelling units for affordable housing. Because of these concerns, the Department of Planning recommends disapproval of this bill. Additionally, we further recommend this matter be addressed in the Zoning Code re-write effort.
