The below information was requested at the September 1, 2021 Public Safety and Government Operations (PSGO) committee meeting in reference to Baltimore City Fire Department (BCFD) take-home vehicles:

- A list to include dates, times, and emergency incident type that each current individual with a take-home vehicle has had to report back to work to respond to while they were off-duty over the last 24-months.¹

BCFD submitted an initial response on October 12, 2021 which included information for employees with take-home vehicles who serve in BCFD's Operations Division. BCFD submitted another response on October 19, 2021 which included information for employees with take-home vehicles who serve in BCFD's Support Services / Community Risk Reduction Division.

This final supplementary response includes information for employees with take-home vehicles who serve in BCFD's Safety Division.
