## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning 1 Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation – 2 Fire Department – \$6,224,688 3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the 4 amount of \$6,224,688 to the Fire Department – Program 212 (Fire Suppression), to provide 5 funding to pay for additional operating expenses; and providing for a special effective date. 6 By authority of 7 Article VI - Board of Estimates 8 Section 8(b)(3) and (c) 9 10 Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition) 11 Recitals 12 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Fiscal 2008 Net 13 Parking Taxes and Miscellaneous General Fund Revenue in excess of the revenue relied on by 14 the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 15 2008. 16 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of 17 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2008 was formulated. 18 19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2008 was formulated or is for a new program that could 20 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 21 On May 14, 2008, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City 22 Council. 23 24 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$6,224,688 shall be made available to the Fire Department – Program 212 (Fire Suppression) as 25 a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2008, to provide 26 funding to pay for additional operating expenses.
