11 **Recitals**

12 William J. Goodwin, Jr., Chief of the Fire Department from 2002 until his
13 retirement in 2007, served the City of Baltimore with distinction and honor for
14 over 30 years. He rose through the ranks of the Baltimore City Fire Department,
15 and during the course of his service, he received 3 Unit Citations and was
16 awarded the Meritorious Conduct Award in 1984, and again in 2001, when his
17 courageous efforts and leadership helped to save our City that summer when the
18 fire occurred in the Howard Street Tunnel.

19 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the
20 Engine Company 41 Fire Station, located at 520 South Conkling Street is named the Chief
21 William J. Goodwin, Jr. Fire Station.

22 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day
23 after the date it is enacted.
