Re: **City Council Bill 11-0731 - Baltimore City Landmark List - Franklin-Delphey Hotel**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0731, which was introduced for the purpose of designating Franklin-Delphey Hotel, 300 West Franklin Street, as a historical landmark.

This bill would designate the Franklin-Delphey Hotel, located at 300 West Franklin Street, as a Baltimore City Landmark. The Commission for Historical and Architectural Preservation (CHAP) has indicated that the building meets the City's Landmark designation criteria.

The Department of Housing and Community Development supports the adoption of City Council Bill 11-0731.
