11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That	
12	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of housing for the	
13	elderly and/or disabled on the property known as 5300 Harford Road, as outlined in red on the	
14	plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 6-309(1)	
15	and 14-102, subject to the condition that the following conditions:	
16	(1) There may be no more than 50 clients.	
17	(2) The housing for the elderly and/or disabled complies must comply with all applicable	
18	federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.	
19	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the	
20	accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning	
21	Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council	
22	shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;	
23	and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
