8 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That the  
9 Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

10 **Ordinance 19-308**

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes  
12 effect on [the 60<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted] MARCH 15, 2020.
