> RE: City Council Bill 08-0108 - Charter Amendment-Department of General Services



Dear President and Members

You have requested the advice of the Law Department regarding City Council Bill 08-0108. City Council Bill 108 proposes an amendment to the Baltimore City Charter that would create a Department of General Services as an Executive Department of City government. The bill provides for the powers and duties of the Department of General Services which are largely powers that are largely being transferred from the Department of Public Works.

City Council Bill 08-0108 is consistent with the powers of the City Council to propose Charter amendments provided under the Maryland Constitution Article XI-A, Section 5. If the bill is passed by the City Council, it will be referred to the voters in the next general election.

The Law Department proposes several amendments to the bill to make it consistent with current City operations and to allow for modification to the powers of the Department of General Services as it evolves as an executive department.

- 1. On page 9, at the end of line 6, after "However," insert "unless otherwise provided in this Charter or by other law,".
- 2. On page 9, line 19, before "No", insert "Unless otherwise provided in this Charter or by other law."
- 3. On pages 14 through 15, delete Section 134 through 137 and insert them with appropriate section numbers, on page 9, after line 29. Change all references to the "Department of General Services" to the "Department of Transportation."
- 4. Re-number Section 138 to be Section 134.
