## AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 2	Zoning – Health-Care Facilities – Conditional Use Nonprofit Home for the Rehabilitation of Non-bedridden Alcoholics –

4	FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
5	operation of a nonprofit home for the rehabilitation of non-bedridden alcoholics on the
6	property known as 2525 Maryland Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

15	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
16	permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a nonprofit home for
17	the rehabilitation of non-bedridden alcoholics on the property known as 2525 Maryland Avenue,
18	as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City
19	Zoning Code §§ 5-204(6) and 14-102 and Health Code §3-102, subject to the condition that the
20	following conditions:
21	1. The maximum number of resident clients is 8.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. Underlining indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

2. There may be no more than 2 persons per sleeping room.

3. 24-hour supervision must be provided.

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1 2	4. There may be no exterior sign on the facility other than a nameplate no larger than 12 inches wide by 12 inches high.
3 4 5 6	5. The nonprofit home for the rehabilitation of non-bedridden alcoholics complies must comply with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements. The number of persons in residence at one time shall not exceed 27 as a combined total for 2521, 2523, and 2525 Maryland Avenue.
7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14	<b>SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED</b> , That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.
