I am herein reporting on City Council Bill 09 - 0371 introduced by Councilmembers Spector and Middleton.

The purpose of this bill is to amend the Urban Renewal Plan for Park Heights to create a new disposition lot, to amend Appendix A to add certain properties for clearance and redevelopment, to amend Appendix B to add the new disposition lot, and to revise certain exhibits to reflect the changes in the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

The Urban Renewal Plan for Park Heights was originally approved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore by Ordinance 08 – 93.

The Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. has reviewed the amendments to the Urban Renewal Plan for Park Heights and has no concerns about them. The Parking Authority would have a member of our staff readily available to City agencies and/or work-groups to help develop parking management plans within this Urban Renewal Plan.

Based on the above comments, the Baltimore City Parking Authority, Inc. supports the passage of City Council Bill 09-0371.
