14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the State of Maryland in	
15	excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to	
16	balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2026.	
17	That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of	
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2026 was formulated.	
19	On October 15, 2025, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City	
20	Council.

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$300,000 shall be made available to the Mayor's Office of Employment Development – Service
3	795 (Workforce Services for Baltimore Residents) as a Supplementary Special Grant State Fund
4	Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2026, to provide funding to support the creation of
5	recovery friendly workplaces and care navigators. The source of revenue for this appropriation is
6	the grant from the State of Maryland in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on
7	by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal
8	Year 2026.

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
