10 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That the  
11 name of Woodall Street, between Clemm Street and East Fort Avenue, is changed to Whetstone  
12 Way.

13 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day  
14 after the date it is enacted.
