Re: **City Council Bill 12-0127 – Baltimore City Landmark List – Appold-Faust Building**

The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 12-0127, which was introduced for the purpose of designating the Appold-Faust Building, 307-309 West Baltimore Street, as a historical landmark.

This bill would designate the Appold-Faust Building, located at 307-309 West Baltimore Street, as a Baltimore City Landmark. It is the understanding of the Department of Housing and Community Development that Appold-Faust Building meets all the criteria for the City's Landmark designation.
