12	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
13	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

18	THE POLICE COMMISSIONER MAY DIVIDE THE CITY INTO AS MANY POLICE DISTRICTS AS THE

23	WITHIN 9 MONTHS AFTER THE UNITED STATES CENSUS BUREAU PUBLISHES ITS

4	Subsection (a) of this section does not apply if, in the 2 years immediately
5	PRECEDING THE PUBLICATION OF THE DECENNIAL CENSUS DATA FOR BALTIMORE CITY,
6	THE COMMISSIONER ALREADY HAS ADOPTED AND IMPLEMENTED A PLAN FOR POLICE
7	REDISTRICTING.
8	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance
9	are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior
10	Ordinance.
11	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 <sup>th</sup> day
12	after the date it is enacted.
