AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

1 **Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation –**
2 **Baltimore City Police Department – \$4,081,157**

3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation in the
4 amount of \$4,081,157 to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201 (Field
5 Operations), to provide funding for planning, equipment, training, exercises, management
6 and administration to enhance the ability of State and local agencies to prevent, respond to,
7 and recover from incidents of terrorism; and providing for a special effective date.

13 **Recitals**

14 The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the U.S. Department of
15 Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Homeland Domestic Preparedness in excess of the revenue
16 relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget
17 for Fiscal Year 2006.

18 That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of
19 Estimates for Fiscal Year 2006 was formulated.

20 On June 29, 2005, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
21 Council.

22 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That**
23 **\$4,081,157 shall be made available to the Baltimore City Police Department – Program 201**
24 **(Field Operations) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year**

 3 recover from incidents of terrorism. The source of revenue for this appropriation is a grant from
 4 the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Homeland Domestic Preparedness in
 5 excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in
 6 determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2006.

7 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it
 8 is enacted.
