10 11	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE , That th Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

15	§ 4-6. Registration statement – Contents.
16	(a) In general.
17 18	Each registration statement must be in the form that the Commissioner requires and contain the following information:
19	(1) a description of the premises by street number or by block-and-lot;
20	(2) the name[, street address, and telephone number] of the unit's owner of record;
21 22	[(3) the name, street address, and telephone number of the unit's managing operator, if other than the owner;]
