10 11	<b>SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE</b> , That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:
12	<b>Baltimore City Revised Code</b>
13	Article – Building, Fire, and Related Codes
14	Part II. International Building Code
15	§ 2-103. City modifications.
16 17	The additional, deletions, amendments, and other modifications adopted by the City are as follows:
18 19	<b>Section 109.5.3 Permit extensions.</b> For a permit extension issued under this Code, the charge is as follows:
20 21	1. If the application for extension is made within [90] 30 days after the permit expires, the fee for the extension is \$25.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law. [Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law. <u>Underlining</u> indicates matter added to the bill by amendment. Strike out indicates matter stricken from the bill by amendment or deleted from existing law by amendment.

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 If the application for extension is made between 31-90 days after the permit expires, the fee for the extension is 50% of the original permit fee. Alternatively, the applicant may apply for a new permit for the work remaining to be completed, with the fee for that permit to be based on the scope of that remaining work.
