10	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the
11	Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

13	Article 19. Police Ordinances
14	[Subtitle 49. Star-Spangled Banner]
15	[§ 49-1. To be performed as entirety.
16	(a) In general.
17	"The Star-Spangled Banner" shall not be played, sung or rendered in the City of
18	Baltimore in any public place, or at any public entertainment, or in any theatre or moving
19	picture hall, restaurant, or cafe, except as an entire and separate composition or number,
20	without embellishments of national or other melodies.
21	(b) Use in medley prohibited.
22	Nor shall "The Star-Spangled Banner" or any part thereof or selection from the same be
23	played as a part or selection of a medley of any kind.]

1	[§ 49-2. Use for dancing or exit march prohibited.
2 3	Nor shall "The Star-Spangled Banner" be played at or in any of the places mentioned for dancing or as an exit march.]
4	[§ 49-3. Performers, etc., to stand.
5 6	And whenever and wherever practicable, the musicians, performers, or other persons shall stand while playing, singing, or rendering "The Star-Spangled Banner".]
7	[§ 49-4. Proprietor responsible.
8 9 10 11 12 13	No owner, proprietor, or manager of any theatre, moving picture hall, or restaurant, cafe or other place in the City of Baltimore where the public gathers shall permit or allow anyone playing, singing, or performing therein to play, sing, or render "The Star-Spangled Banner" in violation of the provisions of this subtitle, and in the event of any such permission or allowance, such owner, proprietor, or manager, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to the penalties imposed by § 49-6 of this subtitle.]
14	[§ 49-5. {Reserved}]
15	[§ 49-6. Penalties.
16 17 18	Any person violating the provisions of this subtitle shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof before a Court of competent jurisdiction of this State, shall be fined not more than \$100.]
19 20 21	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.
22 23	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED , That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30 th day after the date it is enacted.
