1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Repeal – Reisterstown Plaza Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing Ordinance 09-219, which established the Reisterstown Plaza
4 Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan; and providing for a special effective date.

5 BY repealing

6 Ordinance 09-219

7 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
8 Ordinance 09-219 is repealed, and the authority conferred in that Ordinance to establish the
9 Reisterstown Plaza Transit Station Urban Renewal Area and Plan is rescinded.

10 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
11 enacted.
