**INTRODUCTION** – Urban Renewal - Brooklyn-Curtis Bay – Amendment

**PURPOSE/PLANS** – For the purpose of amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Brooklyn-Curtis Bay to extend the time the Urban Renewal Plan for Brooklyn-Curtis Bay remains in full force and effect; amending the Urban Renewal Plan for Brooklyn-Curtis Bay to reauthorize the acquisition of properties within the Project Area and to extend the life of the Plan; waiving certain content and procedural requirements; making the provisions of this Ordinance severable; providing for the application of this Ordinance in conjunction with certain other ordinances; and providing for a special effective date.

**COMMENTS** – Council Bill 21-0162 seeks to extend the authorization period of the existing Brooklyn-Curtis Bay Urban Renewal Plan. The extension is being sought to provide time for local stakeholders to work with the Department of Planning to incorporate desired amendments into the existing plan.

**AGENCY/DEPARTMENT POSITION** – The Baltimore City Department of Transportation does not foresee any direct fiscal or operational impact resulting from the legislation and has **no objection** to Council Bill 21-0162.
