The Department of Planning is in receipt of City Council Bill #14-0446, which is for the purpose of naming a portion of the Stony Run Walking Path, located in Stony Run Park, to be the Adam D. Cockey, Jr. Walking Path in Stony Run Park.

This item has been scheduled for a Judiciary and Legislative Investigations committee hearing before the Planning Commission will be able to review it and provide a recommendation to the committee.
