As proposed, City Council Bill Number 08-0105 would authorize a Parking Enterprise Fund Capital Appropriation in the amount of \$2,400,000 to the Department of Transportation (Account #9965-580-566) to provide funds for acquisition and installation of multi-space parking meters. The sources of funds for this appropriation will come from the Fiscal 2007 Parking Enterprise Fund balance.

The additional funding will be used to acquire and install an additional 280 multi-space parking meters. The existing multi-space meters are currently utilized in the Central Business District, the Westside, Fells Point and Hampden. These additional meters will allow for the expansion of the EZ Park Multi-Space Meter Program to include the western portion of the Jonestown neighborhood. Charles Street from Madison Street to North Avenue, Waverly, Govans, Federal Hill, Bio-Park West, Eastern Avenue in Greektown and lots JFA and JFB under the Jones Falls Expressway.

The Department of Transportation recommends approval of this proposed legislation.
