Dear President and City Council Members:

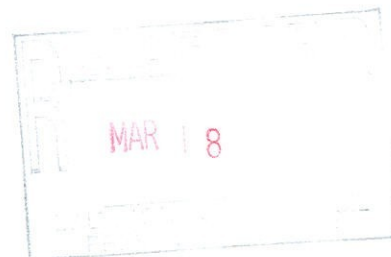
The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 11-0655 for form and legal sufficiency. This corrective bill de-codifies obsolete and superseded provisions now found in Subtitle 1 of Article 13 relating to the Baltimore Housing Authority.
