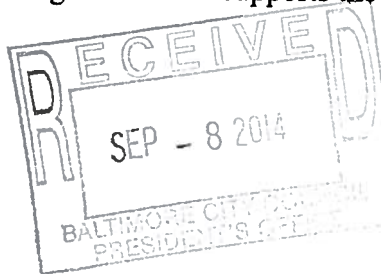
City Council Bill No. 14-373 has been referred by your Honorable Body to the Board of
