Re: **City Council Bill 19-0362: City Streets – Opening – A Variable Width Alley,  
Located Between 2 10-Foot Alleys Bounded by Boone Street, East 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, Greenmount  
Avenue, and East 23<sup>rd</sup> Street**

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The Department of Housing and Community Development has reviewed City Council Bill 19-0362, for the purpose of condemning and opening a variable width alley, located between 2 10-foot alleys bounded by Boone Street, East 22nd Street, Greenmount Avenue, and East 23rd Street, as shown on Plat 284-A-15 in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

If enacted, this bill, along with the accompanying closing and sale bills, will enable Mother Seton Academy to move forward with plans to construct a gymnasium on this block.
