Re: City Council Bill 10-0464 – Bond Issue – Recreation, Parks and
Environmental Improvement Loan - \$12,897,000

Dear Madame President and City Council Members:

The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 10-0464 (Bond Issue – Recreation and Parks Loan - \$12,897,000) for form and legal sufficiency. The bill would authorize the Mayor and City Council to create a debt not exceeding \$12,897,000 (the “Debt”) for purposes of improving the City’s park and recreational land and facilities, and for improving, modernizing, protecting and renovating storm water systems, streams, rivers and other waterways and related facilities.

The intent of the Bill is to ensure that the Debt is created as a general obligation of the City, pursuant to Section 7 of Article XI of the Constitution of Maryland. The Bill also contains provisions concerning the use of the funds, the issuance of the bonds, and other matters. After approval by the Mayor and City Council, the ordinance will be presented to the voters for approval on November 2, 2010.

The Law Department approves Council Bill 10-0464 for form and legal sufficiency.
