3	FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$315,000 to the Department of Housing and Community Development – Service
5	745 (Housing Code Enforcement), to provide funding for additional staffing costs; and providing for a special effective date.

12	Recitals
13 14 15	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents \$315,000 in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.
16 17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated.
18	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
19 20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2025 was formulated or is for a new program that could not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
21 22	On October 2, 2024, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

1	SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
2	\$315,000 shall be made available to the Department of Housing and Community Development –
3	Service 745 (Housing Code Enforcement) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating
4	Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2025, to provide funding for additional staffing costs. The source
5	of revenue for this appropriation is funds from the General Fund Assigned Fund Balance in
6	excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in
7	determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2025.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
