## **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Chairman Costello and Councilmember Ramos gave opening remarks. Councilmember Ramos noted that the focus of the bill is to not get money, but allow more vacant properties to go into receivership.
- 2. Chairman Costello went over the agency reports with agency representatives for the bill.
- 3. Director Moiseyev explained the finance's position and gave additional clarification. It was noted that they think the bill will be revenue-neutral, which is why they have a neutral position.
- 4. Chief of Staff Davis went over their favorable position on the bill and gave additional context. It was noted that the City has 13,108 vacant buildings, and they see this bill not as revenue-inducing, but as a method to motivate owners.
- 5. Councilmember Stokes asked how can sending "significant letters' to owners of vacant be impactful. Chairman Costello explained the legislative intent of the bill the hope is there will be several notices via tax bills, newspapers, water bills, etc. DHCD noted that it will be a multi-faceted approach.
- 6. Councilmember Stokes asked about contact to owners living outside of the City. Chairman Costello noted that DHCD will do more meaningful notices.
- 7. Chairman Costello asked about notices to banks and mortgage companies who hold mortgages. Chief Nealy noted they will have campaigns and have relationships with the banks and companies.
- 8. Councilmember Ramos and Finance discussed lien release for those good faith redevelopments, but more precise policy needs to be hashed out.
- 9. Councilmember Ramos and DHCD discussed hiring a navigator to help those residents who purchased rehabbed homes where the previous owners did not have the necessary permits.
- 10. Councilmember Schleifer and DHCD discussed the new permit liaison, and ongoing issues with the permit offices that constituents face. Chairman Costello noted that DHCD to send an introduction email to the Council on the new permit liaison.
- 11. Councilmember Schleifer asked DHCD to provide data on call rates in the permit office.
- 12. Various members of the public signed up to testify.
- 13. Vote taken; Motion passed Favorable
- 14. Hearing concluded.
