The Law Department has reviewed City Council Bill 13-0193 for form and legal sufficiency. The bill renames the Councilwoman Rita R. Church Pavilion and Recreation Center to the Councilwoman Rita R. Church Community Center.

Article 5, Section 20-2 requires that when City property is renamed, the renaming must be done by ordinance. As Council Bill 13-0193 is such a bill and there appears to be no legal impediment to the bill's adoption by the Mayor and City Council, the Law Department approves it for form and legal sufficiency.
