We are responding to City Council Bill 18-0236 –Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$465,000 to the Health Department-Service 303 (Clinical Services). The bill provides funding for the development of a Sexual Health and Wellness Center that will house Ryan White, STI, and other programs, which provide early intervention services to individuals and families living in Baltimore with, affected by, or at high risk of HIV infection; and providing for a special effective date.

Analysis

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Department of Health. In Fiscal 2018, the Health Department received an appropriation of \$4,891,128 in unallocated federal, state, and special grant funds. The Health Department received grants in excess of the appropriated amount. This bill will make \$465,000 available to the Health Department-Service 303 (Clinical Services) for the development of the Sexual Health and Wellness Center that will house Ryan White, STI, and other programs, which provide early intervention services to individuals and families in Baltimore with, affected by, or at high risk of HIV infection.

Fiscal Impact

This bill has no fiscal impact.

Recommendation

The Department of Finance has no objection to City Council Bill 18-0236.
